Arctic and Alpine Research

Are you interested in participating in **exciting ecological and environmental scientific research**?

The Climate Impacts Research Centre is offering **internships from April through October** based at the Abisko Scientific Research Station, 200 km north of the Arctic Circle. Our research focuses **on terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems** and their interface at the edge of the Arctic. Our researchers work in the field and lab with research ranging from **biogeochemistry, microbial ecology, to plant and animal ecology**.

In the spring you will encounter excellent skiing and snow shoeing. During the summer the midnight sun affords infinite time for hiking and exploring the natural landscape of the Swedish fell. Autumn is the time the darkness returns ushering in the spectacular autumn colours, blueberries, and the northern lights. The work can be strenuous with long hikes and days carrying a backpack. But if you seek an **adventure in one of the wildest parts of Europe**, then join us!

Requirements: Interns must commit to **at least two months** (60 days) to secure funding from the Erasmus Plus student trainee program. All interns must qualify and apply for the Erasmus Plus program to cover the costs of transportation to and from Abisko, housing at the Research Station and living expenses. Please contact your home university Erasmus coordinator in advance. All you need to bring is a good level of fitness and resilience to the changing weather conditions in this arctic environment. If you are interested in joining us, please send us your CV and a short motivation letter with at least one reference. You must provide proof of health insurance.
